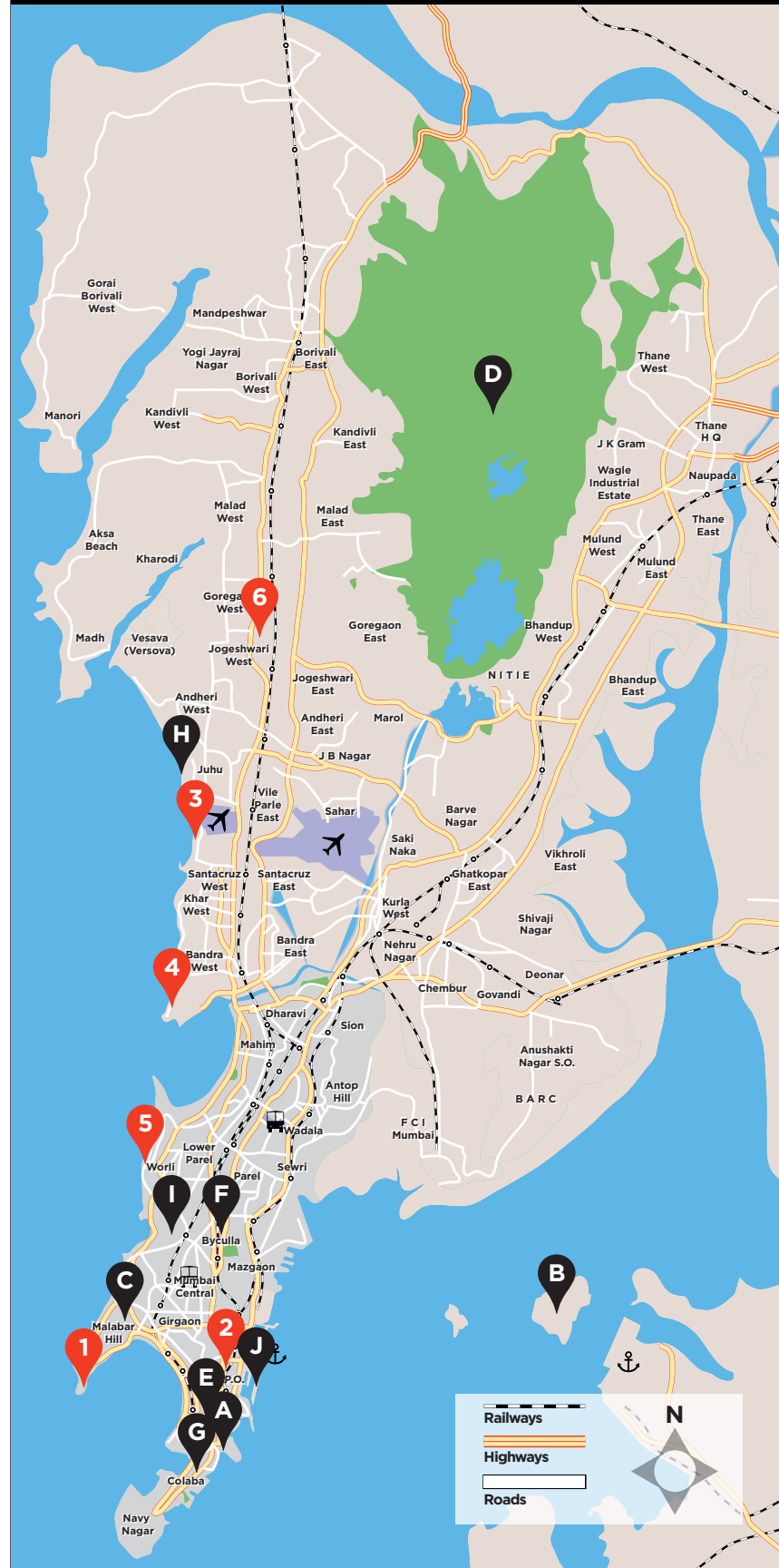


# Mumbai City Map

## GETTING THERE

### BY AIR

Mumbai's 'Chhatrapati Shivaji International Airport' (IATA: BOM, ICAO: VABB) has excellent connectivity with cities and airlines around the world.

The airport offers pre-paid taxi services and is around 28 km. from downtown Mumbai.

### BY ROAD/TRAIN

ROAD: Mumbai can be reached by National Highway no.s 3, 4, 6, 8, 9, 17, and Mumbai-Pune expressway. Air-conditioned cabs and private buses service nearby cities.

TRAIN: Mumbai has three arterial lines. Central line connecting to Southern India, Eastern India and parts of North India. The Western line connects to Gujarat, Rajasthan and parts of North India. The Konkan line connects the coast from Goa to Kerala.

### BY SEA

Several tour operators offer cruises from Singapore, Dubai, Malaysia and other Arab Emirates and South Asian countries. Further, catamaran and ferry services offer connectivity to islands and beaches in the vicinity of the city.

## GETTING AROUND

### BY CAR

Black & Yellow taxis can be hailed on the street. A trip between any two points in the city does not exceed Rs. 1,000. For about 25% more cost, you can book, and travel by, one of the many private taxi services:

### BY BUS

B.E.S.T. offers comprehensive bus services across the city. Most routes run at intervals of between 5 and 30 minutes. Tickets are purchased onboard from a 'conductor'. You can buy a DayPass at the cost of Rs. 25 to be used on all buses except Express and A/C routes.

### BY TRAIN

Mumbai is serviced by three lines:

- The Western line provides North-South connectivity.
- The Central Main Line travels from Mumbai CST to Kalyan via Mumbai's Central Suburbs and Thane, with some slow services running beyond to Karjat, Khopoli, and Kasara.
- The Harbour Line has two sections, one from Eastern Suburbs and Navi Mumbai, up to Panvel. The other runs up to Mahim on the Western Line.
